Computer Skills

Personality Characteristics

I am rational, analytic, and goal-oriented. When confronted with a task or a problem, I will look for a short-cut to a high-quality solution. In this, I am also quite persistent. If I say a task will be done by a certain date, the task will be done (no matter what). I am pretty perfectionist (in the sense that I would hate having to deliver a crappy outcome) but not in a maladaptive way. I am quite good at judging whether benefits in terms of the quality of an outcome are worth the additional time it would take to achieve this better-quality outcome. I am not particularly conformist either. I like to think out-of-the-box. Don't expect me to follow the herd when I think it is heading in a wrong direction. If so, I will speak out, and I will provide arguments to back up my claim. Of course, I will be open to both counter arguments and the concerns of others. My ego is rarely at stake. This generally makes me a quite good team player by whom other team members feel both respected and at ease.

Experience in Research

As a doctoral student and as a post-doc at the psychology department of the KULeuven (Belgium), I have been conducting research on a wide variety of topics, including intergroup relations, racism and prejudice, authoritarianism, religiosity, goals and values, morality, empathy, well-being, depression, self-esteem, perfectionism, attachment, personality, processes of both personal, social and national identity, and parent and peer influences. I have approached these topics from a variety of theoretical perspectives (i.e., developmental psychology, social psychology, personality psychology, motivational psychology, and psychodynamic theory). This resulted in a wide variety of scientific publications and in receiving The Margaret Gorman Early Career Award 2007 [granted by Division 36 (Psychology of Religion) of the American Psychological Association (APA)].

Experience in Teaching

Between 1997 and 2003, I taught practical sessions in Developmental Psychology to Psychology and Educational Science students at the KULeuven (Belgium). Between 2001 and 2003, I taught practical sessions in Psychometrics. In 2006, I taught part of a course in Research Methods in Psychology to Religious Science students at the KULeuven (Belgium), and in 2009 and 2010, I taught a Personality Psychology course to bachelor students in Educational Science at the KULAK (Belgium) and bachelor students in both Psychology and Educational Science at the KULeuven (Belgium). Apart from teaching, I also have extensive experience in giving presentations (see below).

Experience in Supervising

I supervised over 20 master's dissertations and co-supervised two doctoral dissertations. Specifically, I co-supervised the doctoral dissertation of Joke Meeus on the interaction between personality features and group processes in the prediction of negative outgroup attitudes (KULeuven, Social Psychology) and of Arjan Reijerse on the effect of national identity representations (KULeuven, Social Psychology). Finally, I served as an international expert for a research project on religiosity and parenting in the UK.
